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About Holiday Activities and Food (HAF) Programme

Children and young people aged 4 to 16 (Reception to year 11) who are eligible for benefit related free school meals and their families can access free activities during the Easter, Summer and Christmas school holidays.



What is our offer?

During the Summer, we will once again be working with a number of sports activity providers and community groups to offer a wide range of exciting activities and a daily healthy free meal as part of the government-funded Holiday Activities and Food programme (HAF).

Activities include multi sports, dance, music programmes, arts and crafts, drama, cookery sessions and much more, to suit different ages, abilities and interests.

Who can attend a Holiday Activities and Food (HAF) club?

The HAF Programme is for children and young people, from Reception to Year 11 eligible for benefit related Free School Meals (FSM). You can find out more about, and complete an application form for Free School Meals eligibility [here](#).

All clubs cater for children with low-medium levels of SEN and/or disability and children will be considered by each club on a case-by-case basis. The programme also offers SEND specific clubs which are suitable for those children and young people with more complex needs.
